



Have you ever experienced dreams so vivid it seems like you have lived them? Or had déjà vu so strong you're convinced you must have been there before?

Well, Genna, the main character is about to find out the reason she has such feelings a lot of the time. The story opens with a sacrificial ceremony in 2500 BC and immediately the reader is hooked. Switch to present-day, teenage Genna's life is the same as most her age until events at a museum and the appearance of a sinister stranger she encounters looking at an exhibit of knife. Soon her world will be turned upside down.

After she is ambushed in a park, she escapes with the help of another more helpful, mysterious stranger. Terror combines with bewilderment when she is then kidnapped by the same gang and, once again, rescued by the same young man. Introducing himself as Phoenix, he reveals that Genna is a 'First Ascendant', a reincarnating soul from the dawn of humankind. Reborn as her protector in each life, Phoenix must shield her from Tanas, an evil 'incarnate' who is intent on extinguishing the light of humanity by destroying Genna's soul.

Along the way, we see flashbacks of Genna's previous lives: a Roman senator's daughter, a Cheyenne horsewoman and a samurai warrior, all transporting readers to different historical periods. A thrilling plot, exciting characters and fast-paced fantasy adventure.







He feels uncomfortable and isolated when he begins to worry that one of his best friends Liam, might be one of those privileged people who takes everything for granted.

It is going to be up to Jordan, who is stuck in the middle, to keep their group of friends together. But can Jordan do that when he has enough of his own worries about who he is and who he wants to be?

The comic book illustrations are beautifully done and vibrant, but the issues are big and important. There is lots to think about in this brilliant tale of class, friendship and self-acceptance.







This is an extraordinary tale of survival and bravery from start to finish. It is a completely and utterly engrossing story of 13-year-old Sami and his family as devastating events in their country mean they have to flee from their comfortable homes in Damascus, Syria, across the sea and eventually arriving in the UK.

Their journey is full of danger, constant anxiety and they have to make some terrifying decisions to enable them to make it to the UK. There is racism and prejudice thrown towards them throughout and the scene where Sami and his Dad are first in a detention centre will stay with you, it's completely heart-breaking. Yet, it is full of hope too, despite you journeying with them through their ordeal as Syrian refugees; you see moments of compassion and kindness and as you're reading it.

It gives you the opportunity to really think about how you would have felt if this was you or think about how you would have reacted to the family moving into your street.

Be prepared to be thoroughly challenged, gripped and hopeful in equal measure.







It is a beautiful touching story that is a gripping tale of adventure and survival, whilst a powerful story of friendship, family, desperate poverty and never giving up hope.







Sharna Jackson	Mic Drop: A High Rise Mystery


Amateur sleuth siblings Nik and Norva investigate a murder on their estate- one that they witnessed with their own eyes...


Dylan is having a difficult time at school and people can see he has really changed. He's just started his new secondary school and everything is somehow getting on top of him.



Elle McNicoll	A Kind of Spark


Despite the bright pink cover, this story features a dark and troubling part of our history-witch hunting.


